Jump Street (PA Arts Council)

The check for \$1636 has yet to be received. This is due to PA Arts Council internal issues, and is not limited to HGMC. According to an email we received "Community Partnerships RC&D will be responsible for contracting for and administering these funds on behalf of the PCA. Community Partnerships RC&D is a nonprofit organization based in Lewistown, PA, that has been a PPA Partner for more than 15 years. " .
