

# Finance Committee Report for January 20, 2019

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There was not a finance meeting since the last board meeting.

## Annual Campaign – Doug Wentz, Coordinator

- **Donations** to date total **\$8553.00**.
  - **\$5217.00** Total donations collected cash/credit/check
  - **\$1600.00** in total pledges
  - **\$1250.00** in outstanding pledges
  - **\$1700.00** in inkind donations (does not reflect recently added in-kind donations)
  - **\$1636.00** in grants
  - **\$505.00** for NAMG donation

## Grants – Ted Neal, Coordinator

- **Jump Street (PA Arts Council)**
  - The check for \$1636 has yet to be received. This is due to PA Arts Council internal issues, and is not limited to HGMC. According to an email we received “Community Partnerships RC&D will be responsible for contracting for and administering these funds on behalf of the PCA. Community Partnerships RC&D is a nonprofit organization based in Lewistown, PA, that has been a PPA Partner for more than 15 years. “ . We were requested on January 7<sup>th</sup> to resubmit by email the grant agreement form we submitted in October. We did so that same day, and the receipt of the form was acknowledged.
- **The Foundation for Enhancing Communities**
  - We were awarded \$3000, which is the same as last year. The \$3000 was well in excess of the grants we had previously received from TFEC before 2017, so it was gratifying to see 2017 was not a one-year aberration.
  - The check for the grant was received. Required documentation was returned to them.
  - TFEC has added a requirement that we are to include them on any publicity we send out that includes their logo or references their support.
- **TYCO**
  - Our request was rejected. We are invited to re-apply in 2019.
- **UPMC Pinnacle**
  - We submitted a grant request for \$1500 in November. No positive or negative response has been received.
