Spring campaign mailing

The postcards were processed and mailed as was reported as planned in my last report. As of 15 April, we have received \$120.00.

\$100.00 was from a donor who has already donation the same amount in the fall. The other \$20.00 came from a new donor! These additional donations amount to a little more than cover the cost of printing the postcards, mailing labels and purchasing postage. However, the deadline for getting the donations in for recognition at the spring concerts is another five days away, so I'm hopeful that amount will increase.
