Duties and Responsibilities

Prepare and Conduct the Chorus

With input from the Artistic Committee, select music for concerts and outreach performances.

Prepare sufficiently to conduct the music competently and artistically.

Oversee all aspects of concerts. Oversee guest directors, guest artists and substitute pianists.

Lead scheduled rehearsals, retreats, performances both scheduled and outreach.

Choose Section Leaders. Empower section leaders to manage sectionals.

Attend rehearsals, musical retreats, and concert performances as scheduled, except in case of emergency or illness.

Work closely with artistic performers and/or musicians as necessary.

Work closely with committee members to prepare for a new Artistic Director by preparing the library, roster, artistic staff, and calendar.

Attend board meetings. Prepare a written report.
