Summarization of the Proposal/Recommendation

Current:

ARTICLE FOUR - MEMBERSHIP

Section 4.3. Dues

Each member of the Chorus shall be assessed dues on a seasonal basis. The amount of the dues shall be determined by the Board and announced at each Annual Meeting. The Treasurer shall be responsible for notification concerning, and the collection of dues and shall keep accurate records in this regard. Any member whose dues remain unpaid after three months shall be ineligible to perform with the Chorus until his dues are paid. Only members whose current dues are paid may exercise voting rights at any meeting of the Chorus. Dues are not refundable at the time of resignation, termination or separation from the Chorus.

Proposed:

ARTICLE FOUR - MEMBERSHIP

Section 4.3. Dues

Each member of the Chorus shall be assessed dues on a seasonal basis. The amount of the dues shall be determined by the Board and announced at each Annual Meeting. The Treasurer shall be responsible for notification concerning, and the collection of dues and shall keep accurate records in this regard. Any member whose dues remain unpaid after three months shall be ineligible to perform with the Chorus until his-their dues are paid. Only members whose current dues are paid may exercise voting rights at any meeting of the Chorus. Dues are not refundable at the time of resignation, termination or separation from the Chorus.
