Summarization of the Proposal/Recommendation

Current:

ARTICLE FOURTEEN – FUNDS AND COMPENSATION

Section 14.2. No Compensation for Officers or Directors

Officers or Directors of the Chorus shall not receive any fee, salary, or remuneration of any kind for their services as Officers or Directors, provided that, however, these persons may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred with the approval of the Board upon presentation of a receipt, and also provided that these persons may receive reasonable compensation, approved by the Board, for service to the Chorus in a professional capacity.

Proposed:

ARTICLE FOURTEEN - FUNDS AND COMPENSATION

Section 14.2. No Compensation for Officers or Directors Board Compensation

Officers or Directors of the Chorus No person holding an elected board position shall not_receive any fee, salary, or remuneration of any kind for their services as Officers or Directors-at-Large., provided that, however, these persons may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred with the approval of the Board upon presentation of a receipt, and also provided that these persons may receive reasonable compensation, approved by the Board, for service to the Chorus in a professional capacity.

Section 14.3 Professional Compensation

Any person providing a service to the Chorus in a professional capacity as Artistic Director, Principal Accompanist, Musician or any other designated professional position may receive a reasonable compensation, approved by the Board, for fulfilling those services.

Section 14.4 Reimbursement and In-Kind Gifts

Any member may receive either reimbursement or submit an in-kind gift for reasonable expenses incurred with board approval and upon presentation of a receipt.
