**Current Program**: The current program is still on track despite a couple of weeks of turbulence! What little narrative is happening will be completed and assigned by April to give those taking on that responsibility the better part of a month to get ready.

## **Proposed Programs for Next Season:**

Christmas Concert Working Title: **A Christmas Carol: Nobody Does Dickens Like the HGMC**. The concert will be a loose interpretation of the HGMC being visited by three ghosts.

Spring Concert Working Title: **Girls, Girls! A Celebration of Female Composers**. I'd like this to be cabaret style, per our discussion at the retreat. Finding a way to serve booze at this concert might be a great way to attract an audience and to make money.

**Other Issues:** Many moons ago, I brought up the idea of the HGMC purchasing a digital piano. These have come way down in price.
